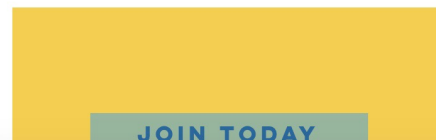
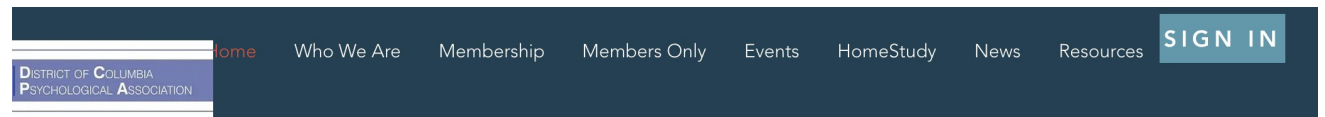




2023: Year in Review

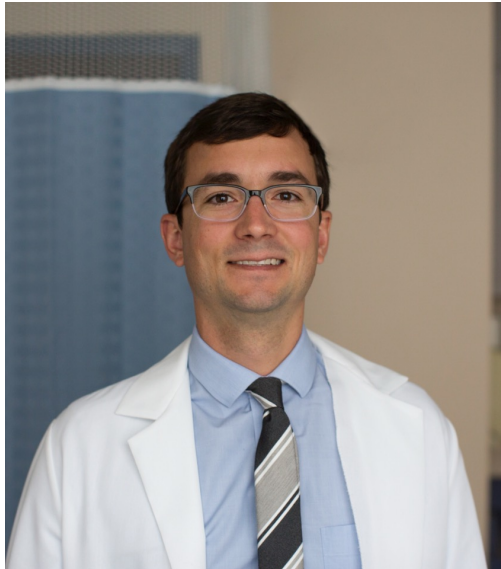
